

RESOLUTION 2004-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AMENDING FIXED EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTION FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL CARE ACT

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Rancho Murieta Community Services District has heretofore adopted Resolution No. 84-9 establishing a Fixed Employer's Contribution for Public Employee's Medical and Hospital Care Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Rancho Murieta Community Services District last amended the Employer's Contribution amount for said Public Employee's Medical and Hospital Care Act in 1999 by adopting Resolution 99-8;


WHEREAS, Government Code Section 22892(a) provides that a local agency contracting under the Public Employee's Medical and Hospital Care Act shall fix the amount of the employer's contribution at an amount not less than the amount required under Section 22892(b)(1) of the Act; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of Rancho Murieta Community Services District resolves that the section of Resolution 99-8, describing the Employer's Contribution, shall be amended to read as follows:

- A. The employer's contribution for represented employees or annuitants shall be the amount necessary to pay the full costs of his/her enrollment, including the enrollment of his/her family member(s), in a health benefits plan up to a maximum of: for self alone represented employee or annuitant \$365.00 per month; for a represented employee or annuitant enrolled for self and one family member is \$700.00 per month; and for a represented employee or annuitant enrolled for self and two or more family members is \$930.00 per month, plus administrative fees and Contingency Reserve Fund assessments. The change is effective January 1, 2005 and is reviewed periodically by the Board.
- B. The employer's contribution for unrepresented employees or annuitants shall be the amount necessary to pay the full costs of his/her enrollment, including the enrollment of his/her family member(s), based on the lowest health benefits plan offered by PERS with respect to unrepresented employees or annuitants enrolled for self alone, for an employee or annuitant enrolled for self and one family member, and for an employee or annuitant enrolled for self and two or more family members, plus administrative fees and Contingency Reserve Fund assessments. The change is effective January 1, 2005 and is reviewed periodically by the Board.
