KEEP GUTTERS, DRAIN INLETS & STORM DRAINS CLEAR

During the autumn & winter months, roof gutters and drain inlets can be easily covered and clogged with leaves and other debris, causing property and street flooding. You can help prevent this problem by keeping leaves and other debris away from the storm drain inlets in your yard and neighborhood.



IMPORTANT TAX INFORMATION

With the approval of Measure J & K in 1998, the Security and Drainage charges on your CSD bill are Special Taxes. Consequently, the amount a **property owner** pays for these charges may be deductible. If you itemize your deductions on IRS Form 1040, Schedule A, you may deduct the aggregate sum paid for the Security and Drainage Taxes during 2022.

CHANGES TO CURBSIDE WASTE SERVICES

As part of our continued partnership with the Community of Rancho Murieta, Cal-Waste wants to share some information regarding solid waste with your community.

ACCEPTABLE AND NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Cart Type	Acceptable Items	Non-Acceptable Items
RECYCLING CART	Paper, Cardboard, Glass, Plastics (♻️), Aluminum & Metal	Food waste, yard waste, pet waste, and other non-recyclable materials.
ORGANICS CART	Lawn and Garden Trimmings, Leaves, Food Scraps & Food Soiled Paper	Plastic, metal, glass, and other non-organic materials.
TRASH CART	Plastic Bags, Plastic Film, StyroFoam, Wax-lined Paper & Non-recyclable Materials	Flammable, volatile, or toxic liquids, aerosols, gases, and other hazardous materials.

Changes have been made to curbside collection as of January 1, 2023, to be compliant with California Senate Bill 1383. Food waste and food soiled paper, such as napkins and paper towels, must now be thrown away in the Gray Cart along with yard waste. The Gray Yard Waste Cart is now considered the Gray Organics Recycling Cart.

Any plastic, metal, and glass are not accepted in the Gray Cart. Please keep in mind that there are plastic items, such as cups or utensils, marked as bio-degradable or compostable and they are NOT accepted in the Gray Cart. These plastic items are not widely regulated for their accuracy of labeling, and they break down over a much longer timeline than yard waste and

food waste. All plastic bags should go in the Brown Trash Cart. Gray Carts are serviced every week on the same day as Brown Carts.

The state mandate to separate organic material has its challenges, and Cal-Waste is here to help through the adjustments to meet compliance. To use the Waste Wizard tool to look up proper disposal of household items and to set collection day reminders, please download the FREE Cal-Waste Recycles Right Mobile App, available on all mobile devices. Development Update

Riverview: Concrete and paving are completed. Contractors are now raising iron and setting meter boxes. The contractor has hydro seeded the site and upgraded its SWPPP plans.

Retreats: Water meter and services have been installed in the two model homes per contractor’s request. The contractor has installed all the water meter boxes. Street lighting and street signs installation is ongoing. Our district inspectors are working with their SWPPP contractors to ensure all project grounds are secure and contained. A punch list is being created for the North utilities.

Circle K/Shell: Gas station concrete slab and awning are built. The contractor is working on getting their fire service installation approved by the Fire Marshall. The contractor is continuing construction on the Circle K building.

Murieta Gardens Lot 2 (Tractor Supply): Contractor has completed most of the main structures including patio walkways and driveways. Contractor continues working on the building amenities including landscape and other portions of the project. Their goal is to be finished by late January.

Murieta Gardens Pet Hospital (Lot 12): Signs announcing project and SWPP plans are displayed.
