

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT, AMENDING CHAPTER 21 OF THE DISTRICT CODE, CONCERNING SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Rancho Murieta Community Services District, Rancho Murieta, Sacramento County, California, as follows:

SECTION ONE:

Findings

The Board of Directors finds and declares that the District's ability to continue to provide security services necessitates, from time to time, the enforcement of various aspects of county and state Governmental Codes and laws, to ensure and protect the public safety of the citizens of Rancho Murieta.

The following provisions of laws are herein adopted by the District and will be enforced and prosecuted to the fullest extent allowed by law.

SECTION TWO:

Section 7.00 of Chapter 21 of the District Code is amended as follows:

Add: **7:15 California Penal Code Section 594 - Vandalism:** Every person who maliciously commits any of the following acts with respect to any real or personal property not his or her own, in cases other than those specified by state law within the District, is guilty of vandalism:

- (1) Defaces with graffiti or other inscribed material.
- (2) Damages.
- (3) Destroys.

Add: **7:16 California Penal Code Section 488 - Petty Theft:** Every person who steals or maliciously takes merchandise from a merchant's premises without their permission within the District, is guilty of petty theft so long as the value of the item(s) taken is no more than four hundred dollars (\$400).

SECTION THREE:

The Board of Directors hereby finds that it is feasible, economically sound and in the public interest for the Board to adopt the provisions of this Chapter as rules and regulations governing activities within the District, in accordance with Government Code Section 61601.13.

SECTION FOUR:

To the extent and terms the provision of this Ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions of any prior District ordinances, resolutions, rules, or regulations, the terms of this ordinance shall prevail and such inconsistent or conflicting terms and provisions of prior ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE:

If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, no other provision of this ordinance shall be affected thereby.

SECTION SIX:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after adoption.




