Title:	Green Waste Diversion	

PURPOSE

The Rancho Murieta Community Services District, in concert with the Rancho Murieta Association, is working with the Sacramento County Department of Solid Waste Management to implement a program of GREEN WASTE COLLECTION for the community. This program will benefit both the homeowners and the County by reducing the amount of green waste going to the Kiefer Landfill.

To maximize the full benefit of the program, the Rancho Murieta Community Services District Board of Directors, hereby adopts the following green waste policy:

- 1) Residents are encouraged to use composting to reduce the amount of green waste sent to the Kiefer Landfill.
- 2) Residents participating in the green waste program shall use the appropriate green waste collection container to dispose of yard wastes.
- 3) Commercial gardeners for residents participating in the green waste program shall use the appropriate green waste container or haul the green waste to a processing facility rather than hauling it to the landfill.
- 4) The Rancho Murieta Association and the Country Club shall endeavor to reduce their respective green waste generation by mulching lawn clippings, chipping tree and shrub pruning, and composting remaining green wastes.

This policy shall continue for as long as the green waste collection program is in effect or for a minimum of five years, whichever is longer.
